2013 DAY CAMP CAMPER BEHAVIOR AGREEMENT

Our utmost priority is the safety and well-being of the campers. With this in mind, we require safe and responsible behaviors from all the children who choose to participate in camp.

- There are **three rules** that all campers must follow:
- ✓ **Show respect and courtesy toward others.**
 - ✓ **Follow directions the first time they are given.**
 - ✓ **Help provide a good learning environment for all.**

It is important that we provide a safe learning environment for all. The following procedures will be followed if a camper chooses to behave inappropriately.

- 1st encounter** – An explanation to the camper specifically detailing the behavior that was inappropriate and/or unsafe.
- 2nd encounter** – An explanation as well as a time out separating the camper from other campers in his/her group.
- 3rd encounter** – A phone call home requiring a parent/guardian to immediately pick the camper up.

Certain behaviors will be considered serious enough to warrant immediate removal of the camper from Day Camp. Examples of such behaviors include: the deliberate injury to another camper, fighting, or intentional wandering off alone. Please discuss these behavioral expectations with your child.
